Marie, as well as between Chapleau and Wawa. We have an exciting opportunity to join our team in the position of a Geriatric Social Worker.

### Duties & Responsibilities:

The Geriatric Social worker is responsible for the development and implementation of the Assisted Living Services for High Risk Seniors. The Social Worker will provide psychosocial assessments, diagnosis and treatments and will work in collaboration with the community service partners to identify and assess individuals to determine eligibility. The goal is to identify services required to enable seniors to remain at home safely, for as long as possible.

### Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Social Work from an accredited university
- Active registration and licensure with the Ontario College of Social Workers
- Minimum two (2) years experience in health care or related social service agency
- Experience in Geriatric care
- Experience in clinical case management
- Ability to interpret social, emotional and behavioural problems as related to medical condition and develop appropriate treatment plan
- Proficient computer skills.
- Demonstrated sensitivity to and knowledge of First Nation cultural values and traditions.
- Ability to work flexible hours including unplanned overtime.
- Ability to travel frequently
- A clear criminal reference check is a condition of employment.
- Must have access to a reliable vehicle and possess a valid driver's license
